Transportation

Everyone has access to safe, reliable and affordable transportation options.



Food Security

Everyone in Elgin St. Thomas has access to affordable, accessible, sufficient, and nutritious food that meets dietary needs for an active and healthy life.



Income Security

Everyone in Elgin St. Thomas has access to banking services, protection from fraud and predatory lending, and the ability to build savings/assets, improve credit ratings, and reduce debt.



Housing

Everyone can find and maintain a safe and affordable place to call home.

Overall Support Functions

Success in our work requires overall supportive functions to deliver results. These areas provide support to achieving the goals of the poverty coalition.

Community Engagement

Actively recruit and ensure the opportunity for all community voices to be involved in the work of the Coalition, with a particular emphasis on those with lived experience in poverty.

System Transformation

Proactively advocate for profound policy and environmental changes at local, provincial and national levels that will have a significant, positive impact on poverty in Elgin St. Thomas.

Research & Knowledge Mobilization

Evidence-informed decisions of the Coalition will be made based on the best available data being available in a timely fashion to the appropriate individuals and groups.
